

Outdoor Learning

Have you ever wished for an outdoor lab in your schoolyard where your students could study nature in a hands-on way? If so, you will be interested in a workshop being planned for you by the Nebraska Wildlife Federation.

Conservation professionals from Nebraska Game & Parks Commission and Nebraska Forest Service will present information on how to create a Monarch Waystation and Pollinator Garden in your district. In addition, the speakers will explain how to plan a garden and what to plant for attracting butterflies, birds, bats and other pollinators.

Every teacher attending will leave with a folder of materials on gardening for wildlife. Each school district* represented at the workshop will receive \$50 worth of supplies that will include seeds and curriculum support materials. NEWF has grant money to support 16 districts, so don't delay! One or more teachers are invited to represent their district.

*Note: NEWF welcomes all schools to send representatives. However, there will be one support package per district.
